

This document outlines the operating conditions, maintenance obligations and liability provisions for the WibitHydroFlow system during its intended use. To ensure proper installation and maintenance, we recommend an additional consultation with your designated customer representative.

Use of the WibitHydroFlow System

The WibitHydroFlow system supplies water to the slide surface of the Wave in accordance with the installation manual.

Warranty Period and Maintenance Obligations

The warranty for the WibitHydroFlow system is granted for 12 months from the call-off date, regardless of the intended use.

A prerequisite for any warranty claims is the regular, proper maintenance and handling of the system by the buyer. The buyer is obligated to perform at minimum the following measures:

- Weekly visual inspection (for leaks, corrosion, wear, error messages, etc.)
- Weekly inspection of all seals for correct fit and damage
- Weekly check for visible moisture inside the housing
- Weekly inspection and reactivation of the drying granulate (e.g. by heating)
- Monthly full charging in a dry environment using the supplied power adapter
- Dry, protected, lying storage when not in use
- Compliance with all requirements of the official operating manual, once provided by the manufacturer
- Bayonet-type connectors must be fully locked (mechanical stop "click")
- When not in use or during transport, the supplied protective caps must be screwed on
- The pin contacts should be treated regularly (for example, during weekly visual inspection) with a light coat of suitable contact grease. One drop per pin contact is sufficient.

If any of these maintenance measures are omitted, all warranty claims shall be void.

Any potential damage or impairments to operation must be reported to Wibit Sports immediately to prevent further harm and to coordinate the next steps for safeguarding warranty claims.

Limitation of Liability / Exclusion of Consequential Damages

Wibit Sports shall not be liable for indirect damages or consequential damages, in particular not for:

- Loss of profit
- Downtime of water attractions
- Progressive damage resulting from defects that were not reported or were reported late
- Damage arising from failure to comply with maintenance obligations or improper use

Important: The original packaging must be retained for any damage or repair case, as returns can only be accepted when shipped in the certified hazardous-goods original packaging.
